



ECHOS ICE SHOW TRYOUTS 2021

Welcome to the Heartland Ice Arena's ice show tryouts! The 2020-2021 Ice Show *Echos* will be produced virtually for safety and maximum visibility. The show will consist of solo and theater ensembles. Solos will only be awarded to those who follow the audition guidelines (which will be held virtually) and submissions will be accepted through Sunday, November 1 until at 11:59 pm. All soloists will be required to participate in corresponding group numbers by level requirements listed below.

Tryout Guidelines

- All skaters will audition to American Horror Story: Coven-La La La Melody. Skaters can use a minimum of 1 minute of the music but cannot exceed the 2:50 seconds <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0LosIXte1V0>
- All skaters are required to create a character and tell a story in the program.
- Skaters are encouraged to create a costume using anything they have at home. The costume along with make-up will help them create and depict their character to enhance the story. No props will be allowed.
- Skaters will create a program and incorporate the following required skills.
 - 1 Moves in the field pattern/or a step sequence
 - Demonstrate 2 executed jumps of choice
 - Choreographic and Transitional Elements such as Split, Stag, Ina Bauer, Spread Eagle, Spirals, illusions
 - Any spin of choice
- Emphasis will be placed on music interpretation
- Incorporate phrase and form (movements & parts of the program to match the musical phrasing) to choreography and elements.
- The entirety of final video need to be shared to google drive using Shannon@heartlandicearena.com
- 1 minute of best phrase form of the program will be uploaded via tik tok using the following @heartlandicearena and #heartlandicearena #hiashowtryouts #echomovement
- Register and pay for the tryout fee
- Those who do not have a tik tok account we can post your video on your behalf. Please let us know your time frame you want posted.

Additional awards and recognition will be given to those with the most original character, costume and social media engagement.

Adjusted Theater Ensemble Level Guidelines

All skaters looking to try out for solos are required to participate in the group numbers to complete the story line of the show. Skaters must meet the level requirements by October 1. Group number placements are as follows:

Senior - Passed Junior MIF

Novice - Passed Juvenile MIF working on Intermediate

Intermediate - Working on juvenile, Pre Juvenile, Preliminary, Pre- Preliminary
